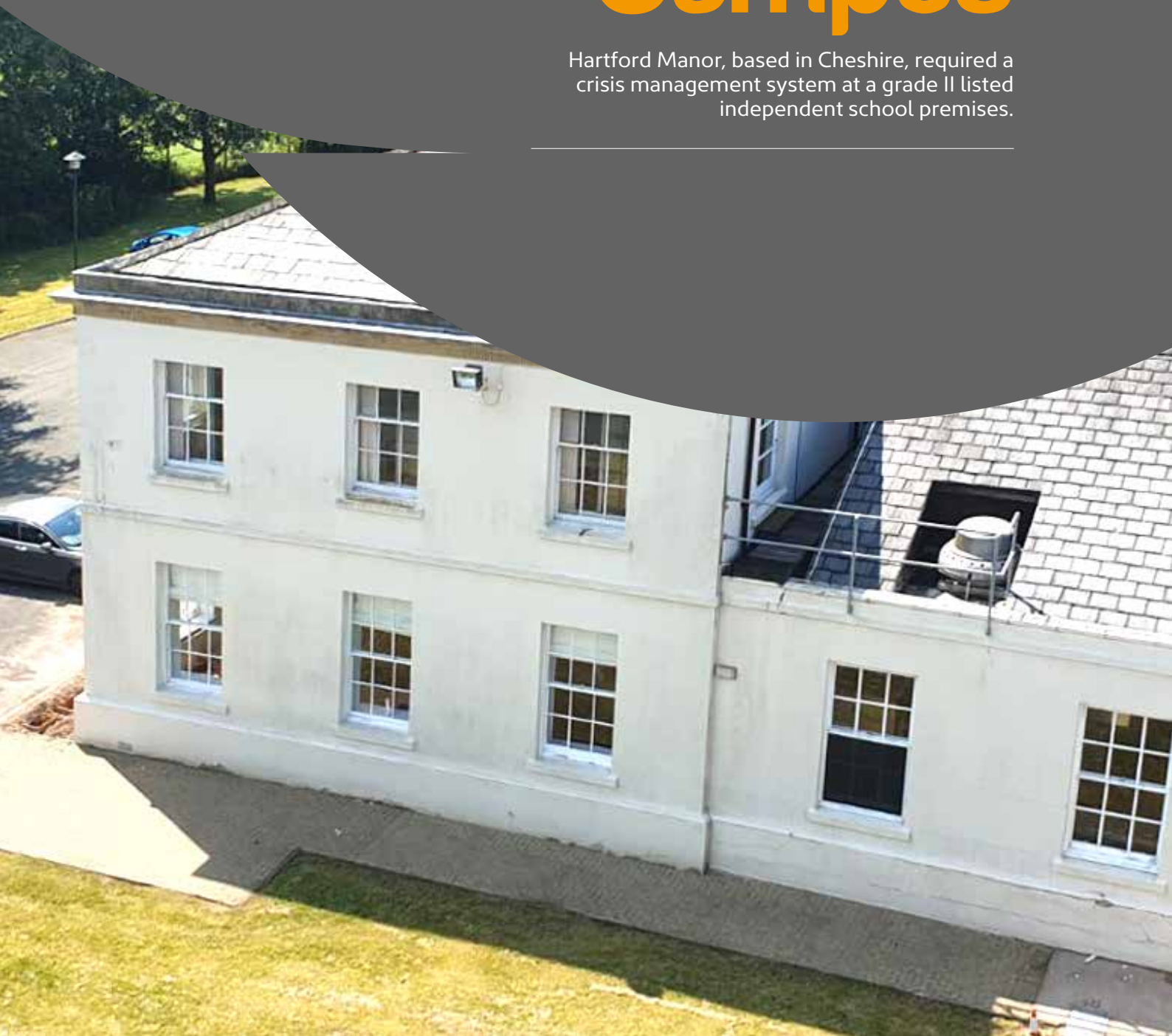

Hartford Manor, based in Cheshire, required a crisis management system at a grade II listed independent school premises.





Case Study

Northwich Campus

Hartford Manor dates from the late 1700s but that did not stop the occupying independent school from installing 21st century IP technology to meet their lockdown responsibilities.

The Problem

Northwich Campus uses modern open learning spaces as well as traditional historic buildings. The school needed to ensure that lockdown alerts could be heard and recognised instantly, enabling students to move out of open "Learning Zones" to designated refuges within seconds.

The Solution

A Lifebell IV system was installed throughout, with accessible call points providing communication to an office in the Manor House building, and speakers covering all areas in and out. The system uses the school's own network points and gives door locking and public address functions from set buttons on the control handset.
